

CODE OF CONDUCT

[expected of **all** students of Fr Agnel College, Pilar]

Strict adherence to various rules/guidelines (already in force and/or which may be introduced later) as laid down by the College / Management / Goa University / UGC / DHE / Government of Goa, including the following:

- Goa University Ordinance No. OC-45.4.3(b) and OA 17; Goa University Circular No. GU/v/Attendance/138/2005/2248 dated 30.08.2005 and no. GU//Attendance/138/2006/6327 dated 8.3.2006 stating that a minimum aggregate attendance of 75% is required to enable a student to appear for the Semester End Examination, failing which the student has to repeat the Semester (re-admission).
- Goa University Ordinances No. OC-45.4.2(e) and OC-66.5.2(g) stating that appearing for minimum of two ISAs of a paper in a given Semester is essential to permit a student to answer SEE of that paper.
- Sexual Harassment is strictly prohibited and liable for punishment.
- Goa University Circular No. GU/III/ADM/2007/376 dated 26.11.2007 and UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging (under Section 26(1)(g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956) which states that ragging is banned in the College and that if found guilty is liable for punishment which may include expulsion from the College.
- Use of mobile phones in College is strictly prohibited; if anyone is found using the same, the phone will be confiscated.
- Possession/circulation of pornographic materials in print/electronic form is strictly prohibited, and shall be liable for punishment.
- Using/carrying alcoholic beverages, tobacco products (including cigarettes) and drugs on the College Campus is strictly prohibited and liable for strict punishment.
- Strict adherence to the dress code on the campus.
- Punctuality to be regularly maintained in terms of timings in College, class and/or laboratory.
- Students are not to be involved directly /indirectly in any way (without prior permission from the Management /Principal) to create, use, print and/or upload material in any media (including online social media like Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and WhatsApp) which can tarnish the name / reputation of the Management/Institution, employee and/or students.
- Students are compulsorily required to carry on a regular basis to the College their Identity Card and Hand Book.
- Students have to compulsorily submit all duty leave, sick leave and other leaves for the month to the class/subject teachers latest by the end of the said month.
- Permission to appear for the College/University Examination will be denied if College Rules and the terms laid down in the Statutes and Ordinances of Goa University are not adhered to.
- College property including books, electronic/electrical devices, furniture, classrooms, fitments, etc., will be duly protected and used with all care.
- Copying in any form during exams/tests/practical's is strictly prohibited.
- Fellow students, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff will be respected at all times.
- Parking of two/four wheelers on public roads is not allowed; students coming to College by their two wheeler have to always wear a helmet besides driving license; those coming by car should have driving license.


