As the Merit Lists for ARTS, COMMERCE and COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (BCA) programmes are out, compulsory COUNSELLING SESSIONS for Admissions will commence and be conducted as follows:

Counselling for students seeking admission to the $\underline{\text{First Year COMMERCE}}$ class is scheduled on Thursday, 15th June 2023 in the College Seminar Hall at 8.45 am.

Counselling for students seeking admission to the $\underline{First\ Year\ ARTS}$ class is scheduled on Friday, 16^{th} June 2023 in the College Seminar Hall at 10.00 am.

Counselling for students seeking admission to the $\underline{First\ Year\ BCA}$ class is scheduled on Friday, 16^{th} June 2023 in the College Seminar Hall at 8.30 am.

During the Counselling, students will be explained about course structure; they will also be counselled on the selection of courses/subjects. All students have to compulsorily come along with at least one parent.

If you do not come for Counselling on date/time mentioned, it will be presumed that you do not wish to seek admissions in our College. In such cases, you may forfeit your seat/place to another on the Wait List. You will then have no further claim on the seat. In genuine cases, for valid reason, if you are not able to come on the said date/time, you are requested to send an email (citing your name and Merit List sr. no.) immediately about your inability to attend the counselling. In such a case, you are requested to appear for compulsory counselling (ARTS, COMMERCE and BCA) on Saturday, 17th June 2023 at 8.45 am in the College Seminar Hall.

After the Counselling is complete and choice of courses/subjects is done, the student will be permitted to register on the DHE-IAIMS portal and make necessary fee payment. The fee payment is to be done in online mode on the portal (kindly get your Debit Card, Credit Card, UPI etc. at the time of admission for making the payment). After completing the fee payment, the student should download the fees receipt and take a print of the same along with the admission form and submit to the College Office.

All students are expected to carry at the time of Counselling/Admissions the following:

- Std XII Leaving Certificate in original
- Std X Marksheet in original (will be returned back on verification) + photocopy
- Std XII Bonafide Certificate in original
- Provisional Eligibility Certificate from Goa University (original) if applicant is from other than Goa Board
- Photo (2 nos.)
- Adhaar Card copy
- Caste or Income certificate (if applicable)

You are also requested to fill the Anti-Ragging form available online (see College website for details). On filling the same online, you are required to download the same and take prints, to be signed by you and your parent. ONLY ON COMPLETION OF ALL OF THE ABOVE THE ADMISISONS WILL BE DEEMED COMPLETE.
